The above designated company agrees to follow the guidelines established for the Preferred Inspector program by National Construction Warranty Corporation, including:

- Submit all required warranty related reports to National on a timely basis.
- Follow all National recommended guidelines for the proper remediation inspections of properties affected by defective/corrosive drywall.
  - Contractors may always exceed the recommendations of National, but may never exclude or do less than the recommendations accepted by National.
- Provide National with at least 5 warranty leads per year
- Provide a website link back to National's website from Inspector's website if applicable.
- Only homes inspected by Level 3 Certified Inspectors may qualify for Selective Remediation.

National will provide Preferred Inspectors the following benefits:

1. Company's name listing by state and city on National's website available to all visitors to the site.
2. Sales leads from National's toll-free inbound calls, web-based leads, and referrals from in-house and field sales personnel.
3. Marketing materials upon request, (pamphlets, brochures, etc).

This agreement can be cancelled by the Preferred Inspector by providing 30-day written notice to National Construction Warranty Corporation. All warranty purchase and payment obligations remain in force until 30 days after proper written notice of cancellation is received by National. National may cancel this agreement if the inspector violates the requirements of the program. Program violation will be documented in writing and provided to the Inspector 15 days prior to cancellation. Upon cancellation, the Inspector must discontinue any references to National, use of logos, trademarks, or any other references to National unless otherwise approved by National in writing.

# How to Attain Levels of Certification

**Level 1 Certification**—requires that inspectors have CDW certification from state programs, BESI, EDI, ASHI, interNATCHI or others and provide us with a sample copy of a past inspection.

**Level 2 Certification**—requires that you have had XRF training through either BESI or a Manufacturer’s program.

**Level 3 Certification**—requires completion of 2 to 3 days of field training with an approved level 3 inspector (those inspectors have a charge for this training.)

All levels of certification require that the inspector notifies National in writing or by e-mail of any I inspection that comes to them from a National referral. We will allow inspectors to link to our website and their information will be listed on our site under Preferred CDW Inspectors.
