The above designated company agrees to follow the guidelines established for the Preferred Contractor program by National Construction Warranty Corporation, including:

1. Provide a National Warranty equal to the value of the total remediation cost or a minimum \$100,000 warranty on all properties remediated for defective/corrosive drywall.
2. Use only an approved third-party inspector/consultant to perform the inspections and reports required by National to qualify the property for a National Warranty. Contractors joining the program may be subject to a probation period and the review of interim inspections prior to warranty approval.
3. Submit all required reports from the third-party inspector/consultant to National.
4. Follow all National recommended guidelines for the proper remediation of properties affected by defective/corrosive drywall. Contractors may always exceed the recommendations of National, but may never exclude or do less than the recommendations accepted by National.
5. Company agrees to not itemized, as a line item, the warranty price on estimates or contracts. Discounts provided to Preferred Contractors are to be kept confidential.
6. Once final approval has been given by National for the issuance of a warranty on a project completed by your company, full payment for the warranty must be received by National within fifteen (15) working days.

National will provide Preferred Contractors the following benefits:

1. Company's alphabetical name listing by state and city on National's website available to all visitors to the site.
2. Sales leads from National's toll-free inbound calls, web-based leads and referrals from in-house and field sales personnel.
3. Reduced warranty pricing off National's current published consumer price list (warranty pricing available at [www.NationalCDW.com/pricing](http://www.NationalCDW.com/pricing)).

This agreement can be cancelled by the Preferred Contractor by providing 60 day written notice to National Construction Warranty Corporation. All warranty purchase and payment obligations remain in force until 60 days after proper written notice of cancellation is received by National. National may cancel this agreement if the contractor violates the requirements of the program. Program violation will be documented in writing and provided to the Contractor 30 days prior to cancellation. Upon cancellation, the Contractor must discontinue any references to National, use of logos, trademarks or any other references to National unless otherwise approved by National in writing.

## Contractor Warranty Guidelines

1. When you start a remediation project you first need to notify National and provide the necessary information for us to start a customer file. Your options are:
  - A. You can go online and fill out the simple "register a project" form

  - B. Call National (800-400-8679) and we can take the information over the phone
  - C. Fax or mail in a project sheet / contract agreement etc.

2. After each oversight inspection you need to contact National and provide a remediation status update for the property.
3. After the final inspection, you need to send National the complete inspection report in order for National to provide a warranty certificate for your client. In most cases you can simply ask the inspector to send us a copy.
4. Payment for the warranty is due in full at completion of your project. No warranty documents will be released until payment is received.
